And when the Sabbath was over, Mary Magdalene, and Mary the *mother* of James, and Salome, bought spices, that they might come and anoint Him. **And looking up, they saw that the stone had been rolled away, although it was extremely large.** And entering the tomb, they saw a young man sitting at the right, **wearing a white robe; and they were amazed.** And he said to them, ‘Do not be amazed; you are looking for Jesus the Nazarene, who has been crucified. **He has risen; He is not here; behold, *here* is the place where they laid Him.** But go, tell His disciples and Peter, ‘He is going before you into Galilee; **there you will see Him, just as He said to you.**’ And they went out and fled from the tomb, for trembling and astonishment had gripped them; **and they said nothing to anyone, for they were afraid.** Now after He had risen early on the first day of the week, He first appeared to Mary Magdalene, from whom He had cast out seven demons. **She went and reported to those who had been with Him, while they were mourning and weeping.** And when they heard that He was alive, and had been seen by her, they refused to believe it. **And afterward He appeared to the eleven themselves as they were reclining *at table*;** and he reproached them for their unbelief and hardness of heart, **because they had not believed those who had seen Him after He had risen.** And He said to them, “Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation. **He who has believed and has been baptized shall be saved;** but he who has disbelieved shall be condemned.
