## NATION OF ISLAM

Islam was brought to the USA by African Muslim slaves. It remained there, hidden and quiet, until it began to re-emerge at the beginning of the 20th century. The Nation of Islam (NOI) is an Islamic political and religious movement that was founded in Detroit in 1930 by Wallace D. Fard (Wali Fard Muhammad). It was quickly taken over by his assistant, Elijah (Poole) Muhammad, and promoted the basic tenets of Islam, a strong family life and traditional Islamic practices. Elijah Muhammad also developed a narrative to inspire black people in America with a sense of their own identity and power, and initially called for the creation of a separate black nation in the southern states. The NOI’s most famous leader, Malcolm X, took over in the 1950s but was later expelled from it and embraced a more orthodox Islam before being killed in 1965. *A fifth of America’s Muslims are black, and half of those are converts to Islam. Pray for black Muslims in America to have life-changing encounters with Jesus.*
